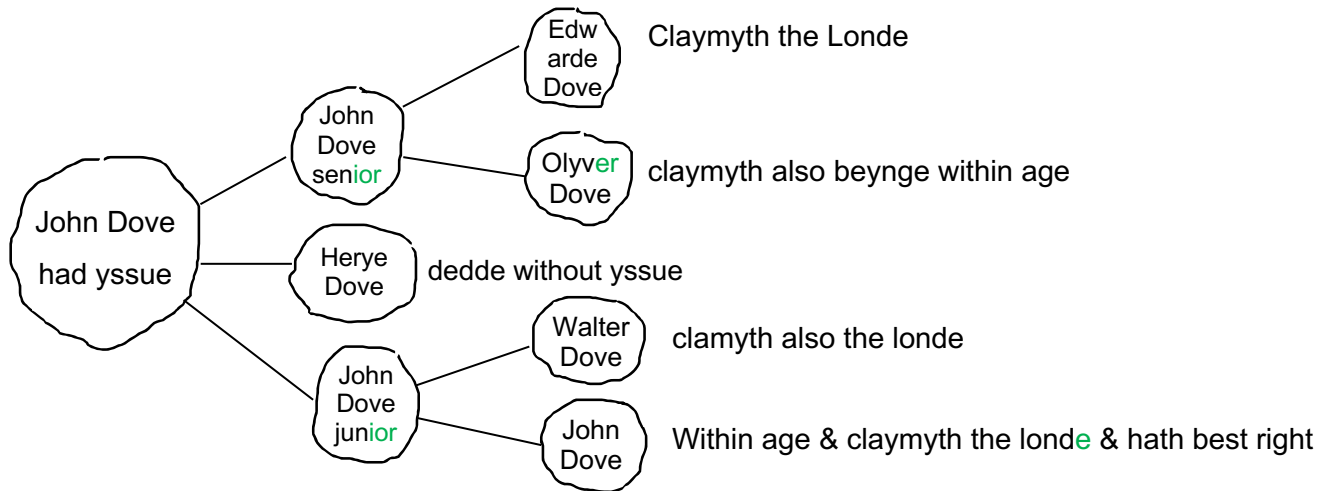

remaynder over to oone Symone Ingolffe & to hys heyres in Fee and that the petygrewe
afore planely made & sett owt ys trewe And So confessed by all the sayde partyes
And Further that the right of all the sayde londes by force of the sayde entaille restith
oonely in the sayde Johne Dove now beyng within age as yonger sone to Johne Dove the
