



The following document is part of a Dulwich Society project to digitise, transcribe and translate the Dulwich Manorial Court Rolls. They begin in 1333 and continue, with some breaks, to 1908.

Text in **red**, apart from modern notes by the transcriber, indicates text missing from, or entirely illegible in, the original Roll.

Text in various shades of **grey** indicates text which, in the original Roll, is to a greater or lesser extent difficult to decipher.

Text in **green** indicates letters missed out of the original text, usually in commonly found abbreviations.

Otherwise, all contemporaneous text is in **black**, except for presumed later additions which are indicated in **brown** or **blue**.

Roll J12 [previously L4] (recto) [Friday] 19 Apr 1588

N.B. The court session recorded on this side of Roll J12 [previously L4] is earlier than that on Roll J13 [previously L3]. The transcription and translation of Roll J12 [previously L4] (verso) (which is later than Roll J13 [previously L3]) have been filed elsewhere.
